Shall the Selkirk Recreation District be authorized to permanently increase its property tax budget base beginning in fiscal year 2027 pursuant to Idaho Code § 63-802(1)(h) to allow the District to collect \$700,000.00 in property tax revenues in fiscal year 2027, for the purpose of funding snow plowing, road and trail maintenance, shuttle services, and general maintenance and operations? The cost to the taxpayer will be an increase of \$33 per \$100,000 of taxable value to bring the total to \$60 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value per year based on current conditions. If approved, the increase shall be permanent and shall be included in the District's property tax budget base for purposes of calculating future annual budget limitations under Idaho Code § 63-802.

Shall the Board of Commissioners of the Northside Fire Protection District be authorized and empowered to temporarily increase its annual budget from property tax levy, pursuant to Idaho Code Section 63-802(3), in the amount of six hundred eighty-nine thousand, one hundred twelve and no/100 dollars (\$689,112) commencing with the District's fiscal year 2027

for a period not to exceed two (2) years, for the purpose of maintaining staffing levels, equipping and maintaining the Northside Fire District's operations, and providing fire protection and emergency medical services, as provided in the resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the Northside Fire Protection District adopted on March 9th, 2026? OFFICIAL STATEMENT: The estimated cost to the taxpayer of the proposed levy is a tax of \$21.00 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The dollar amount estimated to be collected each year from the levy is \$689,112. If the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is expected to increase by \$21.00 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, for a total of \$41.00 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value.

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of Joint School District No. 272, Kootenai and Bonner Counties, State of Idaho (the "District") be authorized and empowered, upon the affirmative vote of fifty-five percent (55%) of the electors of the District voting in the election, to levy a School Plant Facilities Reserve Fund Levy in the amount of up to Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2026, and continuing each year in the amount of up to Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) for five (5) years through fiscal year ending June 30, 2031, for the purposes permitted by law for school plant facilities levies?

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$30.24 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.

Shall the Board of Commissioners

of the Westside Fire Protection District be authorized and empowered to permanently increase its budget, pursuant to Idaho Code §63-802, to defray its costs of staffing, hire and equip additional firefighter/EMTs, maintain the Fire District's operations to protect property against fire and to provide life preservation services, from the current levied property tax amount of \$675,221 to \$1,055,221, an increase of three hundred and eighty thousand and no/100 dollars [\$380,000.00] commencing with the Fiscal Year 2027 and which shall then be established as the base budget for the purposes of Idaho Code §63-802, as provided in the resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the Westside Fire Protection District adopted on March 11, 2026?

STATEMENT: The levy will be used to increase the number of firefighter/EMTs, from one per day to two per day, in the Westside Fire Protection District (an increase of 3 full time firefighter/EMTs to a total 6 full time firefighter/EMTs), maintain the Fire District's operations, and will be a tax increase of \$24.00 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based upon current conditions, for a total of \$67.00 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based upon current conditions.
